

Spiritual Gifts

What the Word of God Says:

1Co.12:7 Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

1Co.12:8 To one there is given through the Spirit the message of **wisdom**, to another the message of **knowledge** by means of the same Spirit,

1Co.12:9 to another **faith** by the same Spirit, to another gifts of **healing** by that one Spirit,

1Co.12:10 to another **miraculous powers**, to another **prophecy**, to another **distinguishing between spirits**, to another speaking in different kinds of **tongues**, [a] and to still another the **interpretation of tongues**. [b]

1Co.12:11 All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.

1Co.12:12 The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ.

Ro.12:6 We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is **prophesying**, let him use it in proportion to his [b] faith.

Ro.12:7 If it is **servicing**, let him serve; if it is **teaching**, let him teach;

Ro.12:8 if it is **encouraging**, let him encourage; if it is **contributing to the needs of others**, let him give generously; if it is **leadership**, let him govern diligently; if it is showing **mercy**, let him do it cheerfully.

Ep.4:11 It was he who gave some to be **apostles**, some to be **prophets**, some to be **evangelists**, and some to be **pastors and teachers**,

Ep.4:12 to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up

Ep.4:13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

1Pe.4:10 Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.

1Pe.4:11 If anyone **speaks**, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God. If anyone **serves**, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.
